

Authorized by Congress in 1947, the Pacific States Marine Fisheries Commission (PSMFC) is one of three U.S. marine interstate commissions dedicated to resolving fishery issues.

Member States: California, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, and Alaska

PSMFC's Aquatic Nuisance Species Program started in 1999 as a response to the threat ANS pose to fisheries resources and habitat.

Zebra/Quagga Mussels are the primary species of concern



Columbia River Basin (CRB) prevention efforts focus on watercraft interception stations

The 4 CRB states <u>combined</u> spend ~ \$ 2 million/yr on watercraft interception programs

WA, OR, and ID have a boater sticker / registration fee to pay for watercraft inspection programs, MT & BC general funds

Minimal federal funds support state watercraft inspection program



# 2012 Watercraft Inspections by State $N = \sim 910,000$




## Intercepted Dreissenid Contaminated Watercraft by Source 2012

#### 1. QUAGGA MUSSEL LISTING

- Quagga Mussels, which we encounter most often in the West, are not on the injurious species list (Lacey Act) ...making law enforcement action more difficult
- To administratively add Quagga's to injurious list is a lengthy process (5 years)
- Legislative listing of Quagga Mussel: For rapid addition to injurious species list (Lacey Act) ...
- On 4/30/13, Rep. Joseph Heck [R-NV3] introduced H.R. 1823: 'Protecting Lakes Against Quaggas Act of 2013' (PLAQ Act of)

#### H. R. 1823

To amend title 18, United States Code, to prohibit the importation or exportation of mussels of a certain genus, and for other purposes.

## IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES APRIL 30, 2013

Mr. HECK of Nevada (for himself and Mr. AMODEI) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

#### **A BILL**

To amend title 18, United States Code, to prohibit the importation or exportation of mussels of a certain genus, and for other purposes.

This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Lakes Against Quaggas Act of 2013" or as the "PLAQ Act of 2013".

Section 42(a)(1) of title 18, United States Code, is amended—

(1) by striking "of the zebra mussel of the species Dreissena polymorpha;"; and by inserting after "Hypophthalmichthys nobilis;" the following: "of the species of mussels of the genus Dreissena"
